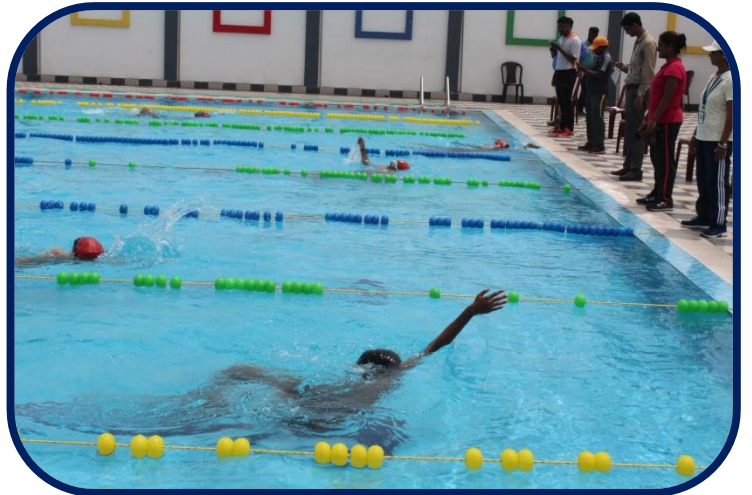
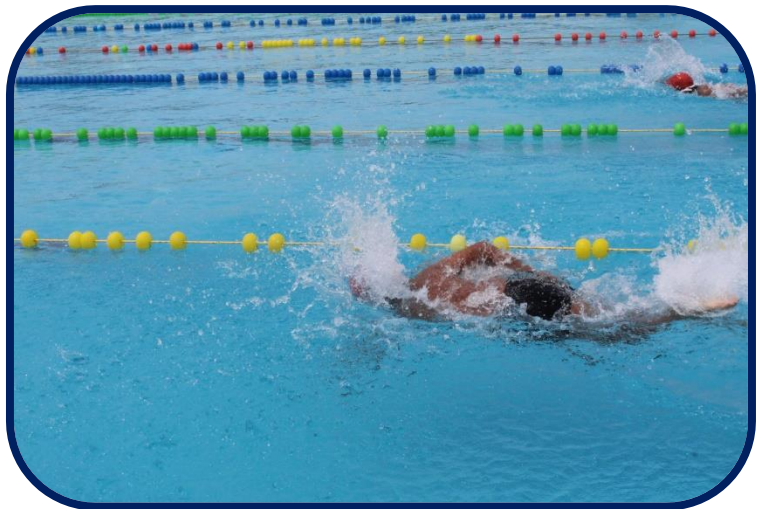

- 3) Assessment life skills

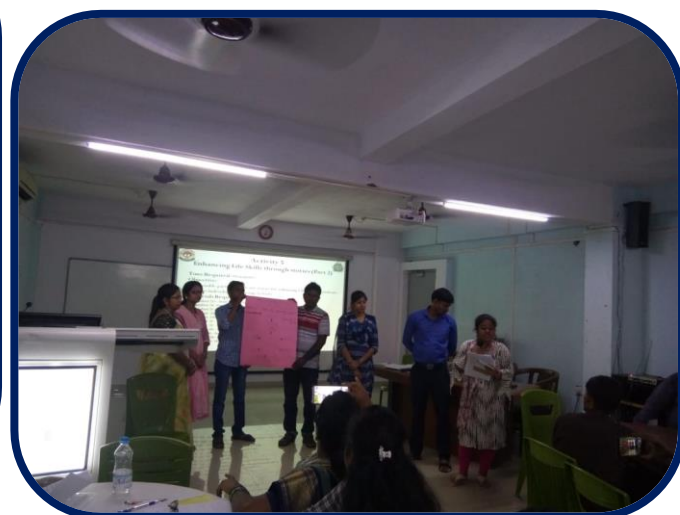
### PRACTICAL SESSIONS
