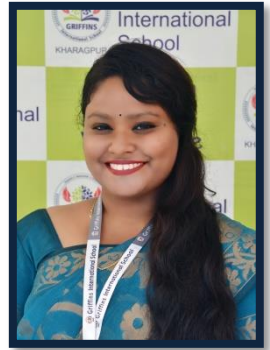
I aspire to create active minds with clear concepts of life and values. My responsibility as a teacher is to mould the lives of children just like a Potter mould the clay to give a proper shape.
