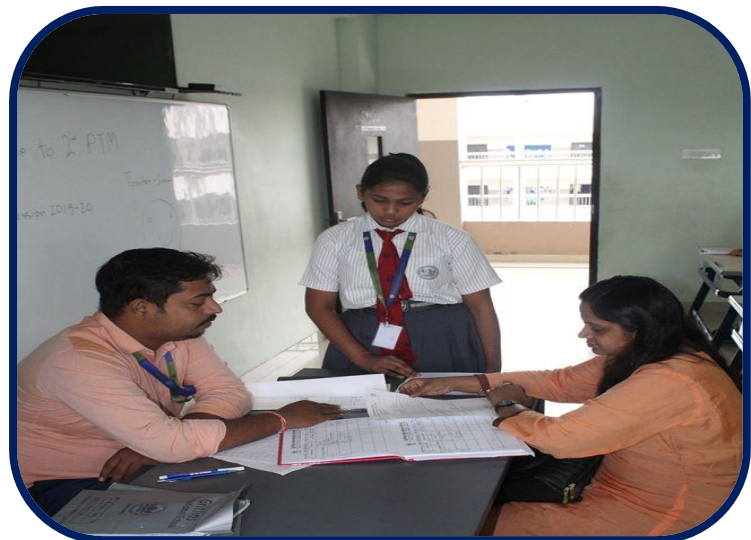
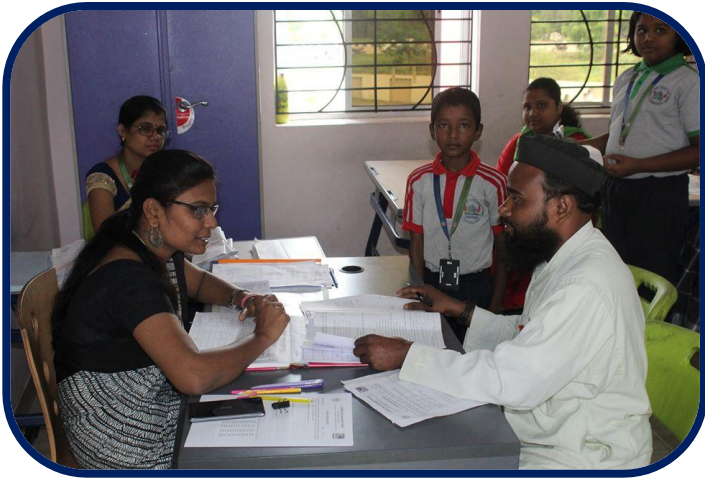


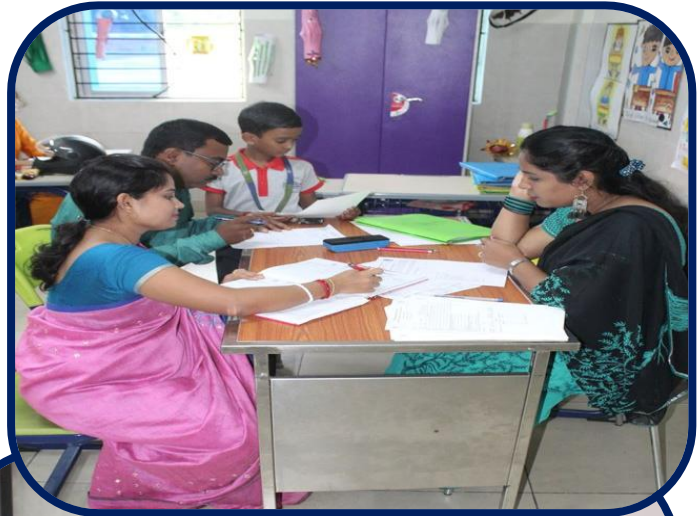
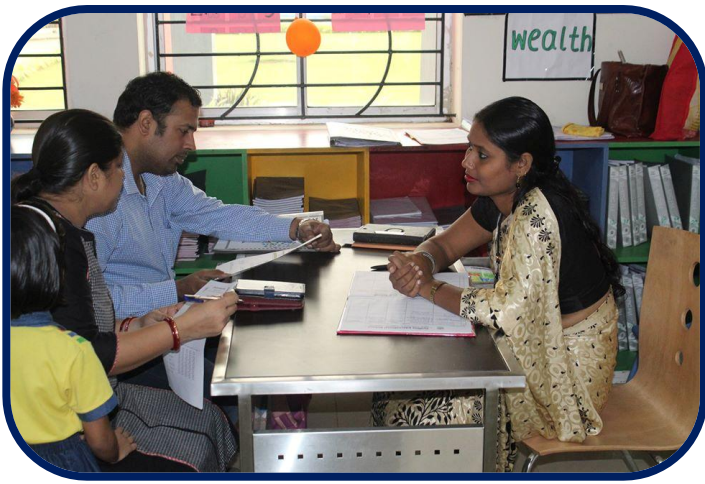
2nd PARENT TEACHER'S MEETING

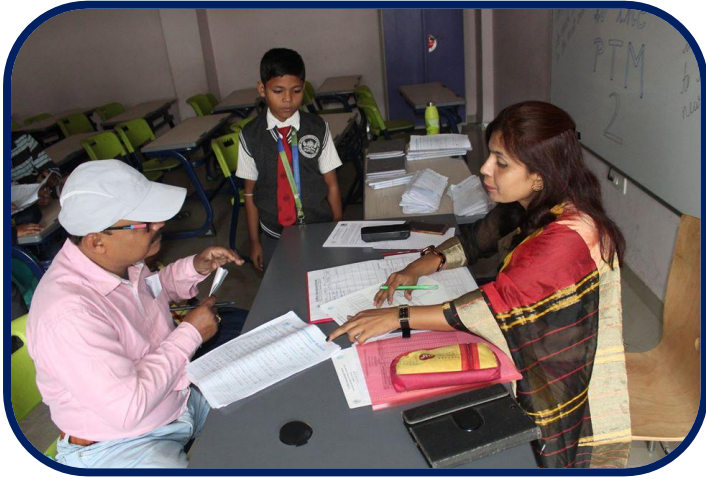
