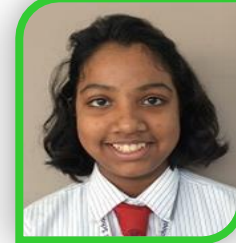

CBSE SPORTS REPORT

Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) Physical education and Sports organises annual inter school competitions for the students of its schools of all the clusters and zones who are then further selected to compete for national level. This is organised by CBSE with a motive to encourage more student participation in Sports and Physical activities. The sports events were categorised into Cluster level and Zonal level.
