

It was duly attended by the teachers, who were all the way amazed by the vision and outlook of this persona. They were captivated by the way he







In order to promote and integrate gender sensitivity to the process of education, C. B. S. E. New Delhi organized a one day workshop on Gender Sensitivity for the teachers of CBSE schools.

Mrs. Subhra Chatterjee extended her warm welcome to the resource persons as well as to the teachers who were there to attend the workshop. About 19 schools from different location of west Bengal participated.

In the introduction session, Ms. Sutapa Acharya encouraged the participating teachers about the importance of gender sensitivity at schools and other work places in the fast changing scenario of modern age. She also outlined that discipline in the workplace must not be looked upon as exploitation or violation of gender sensitivity and gender equity. She divided the participants into groups of 5 teachers in a group, followed by a discussion on the meaning, purpose and need of the gender sensitivity in the school and conducted an interactive workshop. The handouts after every activity helped us with a hands on practice and also helped us to analyse the understanding of the concept. She clearly clarified the difference between the two words - "Sex" and "Gender" and demonstrated the Role Of Power in Gender Relationship through a PowerPoint presentation.

She also explained the role of a teacher as well as how important it is to have a Gender Sensitive School. She advised not to discriminate between boy and

girl students in the class. She inspired us to identify the individual abilities and talents of the students and try to promote them. The awareness of gender sensitivity was developed and boys' and girls' attributes with similarities and differences were discussed.

In the post lunch session, the participating teachers were again divided into groups, based on subject common in them, and were assigned to develop a lesson plan including gender sensitivity. Each group prepared a lesson plan focussing on Gender sensitivity and then exhibited a demo class. The groups enacted short skits on issues like Dowry system,

Female Infanticide, empowerment of girls, etc. Ms. Sutapa Acharya suggested and encouraged us for a gender sensitive classroom environment and methodologies.

The workshop ended with a thank you note by the venue Principal. She expressed her happiness on the successful organization of the workshop and

thanked all for their contribution.

### SUMMARY OF THE TRAINING

The Vedic Math training was conducted by Mr. Gourav Tekriwal, who is the

president of the Vedic Math Forum India and his associate Mr. Sayan Bhattacharyya. Vedic maths is the world's fastest mental maths system, which makes calculations more easy and helps students to excel in their academics and so on.

There were three trainee teachers who have attended this training. It was a three days training program which started with the simple concepts followed by the complex ones. The Vedic Math covers the concepts of:



- > Addition & Jakow method of addition
- > Instant subtraction by all from 9 and last from 10.
- Multiplication- Base method (below the base, above the base, above and below the base), multiples and submultiples, vertically and crosswise pattern, etc.
- > Check for addition, subtraction & multiplication from digit sum check method.
- Fractions, decimals & recurring decimals.
- > Percentages- fractions with composite and prime denominators.
- > Division-dividing by 9 & by flag method.
- Squares and square roots.
- > Cubes and cube roots & raising to fourth and higher powers.
- > Divisibility Test.



- > Pythagoras Theorem.
- > Algebraic calculations.
- ➤ Linear equations in one variables- part-1 & part-2 & simultaneous equations.
- Quadratic equations- the Vedic way
- > Calenders- Sakuntala's Devi method.
- > Math meditation-time distortion and mind calculations.

For every concept there were few hands-on questions which we, the trainee



teachers did as a practice. We were provided with the study materials of Vedic math written by Mr. Gourav Tekriwal. He also provided the syllabus for the math club which we will be implementing in our school. In between the sessions, there were few interesting topics like kenken puzzles, kakuros puzzles and rubik cubes, which were like jewels to the training. Mr. Sayan showed us the algorithms to solve the rubik cubes in

few seconds.

At the end of the training we received the certificates for the Vedic math from our honorable chairman Mr. Abhishek Yadav along with the feedback for the training.

It was a great experience to be in this training with such renowned personalities. The whole session was very interesting and full of new tricks. We enjoyed it and during the math lab classes, the students will enjoy this too.
