Boys' Boarding House:

The learning experience at boarding school is very different to the one at day school. Boarding schools have the advantage of being able to design and implement a curriculum that challenges and inspires their students.

The school Management started with Boys' boarding house from session 2022-23 with a thought process of providing students programs and activities which involves exploration, making friends is paramount and success is celebrated.

Currently we have 26 students for classes 4 to 12 on board. Grade 4 to 8 we have students staying in Dorms, two dorms are functional. For higher grades 9 to 12 we have twin sharing room facility. Parents are allowed to opt for weekly boarding facility wherein child gets to spend weekend with parents.

Integrated School Program (ISP):

It has been observed students who are JEE and NEET aspirants start very enthusiastically but struggle to strike a balance between Board Exam prep and competitive exam coaching. In some part of our country this issue has been addressed beautifully by embedding it into one program called INTEGRATED SCHOOL PROGRAM (ISP) to help student emerge successfully on both the fronts. It has been a tried and tested model.

Our School Management decided to leverage from the thought process and started with ISP in collaboration with Scholar's Den exactly two years ago. So, first batch of our students for this two years program is underway and will appear for the JEE and NEET exam in 2022-23. We are very hopeful of stupendous performance of our students.

ALUMNI Placement:

Our first outgoing Grade 12 batch of 45 students have made us proud. We can boast for their placement in top ranking university in India and abroad.

Reek Jana got selected in International Business Management in Technical University of Applied Science Berlin, Germany. Stella Das is studying Pol Science Hons in Delhi Univ, Pranav Tyagi is doing Chem Hons from Jamia Millia Delhi, Tanya Dhul and Prashant Oroan in NIT Agartala and Durgapur respectively, 8 students studying in KIIT (Kalinga Univ. of Industrial Technology) are just the few placements.

From all standards this is pretty impressive beginning. Just imagine how Griffinites will be scripting history 5 years down the line.

Board Exam Result:

This year we had second batch of grade 10 and first batch of grade 12 CBSE Board Exam. Hoimanti Ganguly scored highest aggregate score of 97.4 in Science Stream followed by Tania Dhull with 92.2%,

Reek Jana our topper for Commerce Stream with a score 80.4% and Anushka Sarkar topper of humanities Stream with a score of 86.4%. Hoimanti scored 100/100 in English.

Grade 10 Board result is truly to boost about with a batch average of 81.67% Sounit Bose topped with an aggregate score of 97.4, followed by Shantanu Mallick - 97.2 and Shruti Nayak - 96.8. 16 students scored an aggregate score of 90% and above in the batch with Highest score of 99 in English, Hindi, Bengali, Science, SST, AI and 95 in Mathematics.
